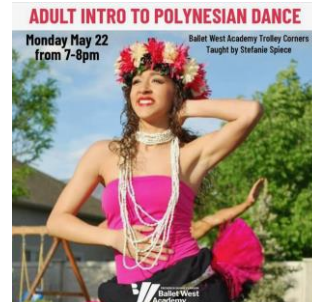
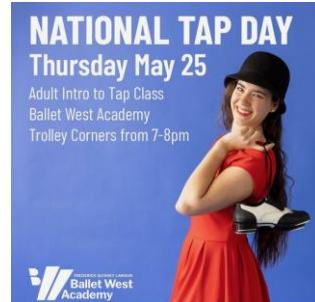
## THE ACADEMY IN THE NEWS
